A few Questions and Answers

Q: When is the Conference?

A: The conference will begin with registration at 3pm on Sunday, February 17th. We will finish the conference on Tuesday night with worship. Joint Recruitment will take place on Wednesday, February 20th. A tentative schedule will be available on the NLOMA website.

Q: Where is the Conference?

A: The Redemptorist Renewal Center in Tuscon, AZ. This is a change from our original plans so please make note. You can see more of the center on their website.

Q: What is the cost?

A: There are two housing options: Single occupancy rooms and double occupancy rooms. Rate for single occupancy cost is \$520 for conference and JR. Double occupancy cost is \$400 for conference and JR. The rate for JR only is \$210. Emerging leaders scholarship funds are available!

Q: Where should I fly in/out of?

A: If you are coming for the NLOMA Conference and/or JR only, please fly in and out of Tuscon, AZ. If you are planing to attend Best Practices as well, you will want to fly out of Phoenix, AZ. If you can fly into Tuscon and out of Phoenix, that would be best. If you need to fly into Phoenix, we will work with you to find shuttle service.

Q: What about the Best Practices for Ministry Conference?

A: We encourage you to stay and participate in the Best Practices conference. That conference takes place in Phoenix beginning Thursday, February 21st. We will have a shuttle available to take you to that conference from the NLOMA conference on Thursday morning.
