

NLOMA Gathering at Camp Omega and COVID-19

The staff of Camp Omega are looking forward to having you here for this fall's NLOMA Gathering! During this crazy and stressful time, we hope to provide an environment that is restful and refreshing. In light of the pandemic, there are a few precautions being asked of guests to adhere to taking into account local and state health officials' recommendations and executive order mandates.

Prior to and post event:

- All guests are asked to complete the Camp Omega's COVID-19 agreement and monitor for symptoms of COVID prior to arrival and for two weeks following the event.
- Please refrain from attending if displaying symptoms of COVID prior to the event
- Inform the Camp Omega staff and the NLOMA board if they develop symptoms within the two-week window following the event.
- Guests are encouraged to limit social interactions two weeks prior to and following the event and maintain good hand hygiene and mask etiquette.

While on site it is encouraged that all guests will respect personal boundaries and proactively learn how comfortable others are with close interactions. With that in mind, the following are being recommended of all guests of Camp Omega:

- Maintain the recommended 6 ft of physical distancing.
- Wash hands before and after activities and meals, taking special care to sanitize following interacting with high touch surfaces (doorknobs, light switches, etc.)
- Follow food service practices as directed by the camp staff
- Wear face coverings as mandated by Executive Order 20-81 in all closed public spaces and outdoor spaces if physical distancing cannot be maintained (Beta Center, Dining Hall, and the office). This recommendation does not apply when outdoors and/or able to physically distance themselves from other groups or in their assigned living spaces.
- Have immediately available face coverings in the event they are needed.
