- Dedicated Christian with a personal growing relationship with Jesus who is willing to share faith in Christ with others
- Ability to lift and carry 50 pounds
- Ability to walk for extended periods of time on uneven and/or hilly terrain
- Previous camp experience preferred

Expectations

- Manage time and complete projects in a timely manner
- Actively pursue personal spiritual development and practice
- Represent the ministry of Camp Luther positively both when working and during off time
- Attend weekly meetings with supervisor
- Willingness to work an inconsistent schedule, sometimes with long hours on weekends
- Actively support members of year-round staff
- Show hospitality to all guests and customers

- Assist in cleaning camp to provide a comfortable experience to all guests
- Perform other duties as assigned
