MINISTRY DESCRIPTION

OVERVIEW

The Community Ministry Specialist is to serve Camp Lone Star by carrying out the Mission and Core Values as a member of the Program Ministry Team at our La Grange Campus. This full-time position reports directly to the Director of Programs.

- Ensure the safety and quality of experience for all guests attending our community events
- Assist with leading our Programmed Events & Outdoor Education program
- Serve as a guest group host and program facilitator
- Assist and perform facility cleaning and preparation
- As a CLS Team member, willing to assist in any task that will further our Mission and live out our Core Values for the transformation of lives and growth of God's Kingdom

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

SPECIFIC MINISTRY DESCRIPTION BREAKDOWN

SUMMER CAMP MINISTRY RESPONSIBILITIES (40%)

- Assist in creating, developing, and organizing an intentional and Jesus-focused camp experience for youth, adults, and volunteers attending Camp Lone Star
- Assist Director of Programs in planning, scheduling and implementation of Day Camp and Urban Base Camp programs
- Responsible for overseeing the Summer Day Camp program and assisting the Day Camp Coordinators as needed prior to and throughout the summer
- Responsible for overseeing the Urban Base Camp program and assisting the weekly facilitators as needed prior to and throughout the summer
- Oversee Trading Post including Inventory management and training summer staff on TP operation
- Assist the Director of Programs in Bible study curriculum writing, and training Summer Staff to use, for day camper and Urban Base Camp use
- Ensure safety of all participants and the upkeep of all equipment used
- Assist in summer camp promotion through Chapel visits to supporting schools

OTHER PROGRAM & RETREAT MINISTRY RESPONSIBILITIES (40%)

- Oversee and schedule all offsite programmed church events including but not limited to chapel visits and youth nights
- Assist the Director of Programs in planning the Chapel visit outline and needs
- Oversee and coordinate on site community events including Spring Break Day Camp and Family Fun Nights
- Manage and track inventory for Trading Post including online orders and shipping
- Oversee and coordinate Camp Lone Star's presence at community events (i.e. Schmeckenfest, Back to School, local church trunk or treat, etc.)
- Oversee and coordinate Work Weekend(s) with the Director of Facilities
- Serve as a retreat guest group host and program facilitator
- Assist Program Team in set up (before) and clean up (after) guest groups or program groups

OTHER RESPONSIBILITIES (20%)

- Champion our Mission and Core Values to the Program Team & other team members
- In partnership with the Chief Executive Officer and Marketing Coordinator to live out a strategic communication plan, by providing content, photos, and information to be used in social media development and posted content to publicize our Summer and Programmed Event ministries
- Assist in facility and laundry cleaning
- Attend approved professional training seminars and conferences
- Attend required staff meetings and devotions
- Assist in evaluating current operating procedures and make recommendations as they arise
